

#### GET YOUR FEET WET AT ONE OF THE MANY BEACHES



- 13 Listen for songbirds and





- See (and hear!) wild sea lions resting on the docks at *Pier 39*

- 22 Experience the unique views at Ina Coolbrith park
- Hug our state tree, the redwood, at the bottom of the *Transamerica Building*
- Climb to the top of the rocky outcrop at Corona Heights Park

## ANYWHERE OUTDOORS IN THE CITY:

Check them off when you've completed each activity

- Find a good climbing tree or balancing log
- Lay in the grass and watch the sky
- Trace the shadow of trees on the sidewalk
- Look for bumble bees pollinating flowers spring/summer
- Listen for bird song (how many different voices can you hear?)

- Balance some rocksPlant a seed and watch it grow
- Gently turn over a rock to see what creatures are living under i (and then gently put it back!)
